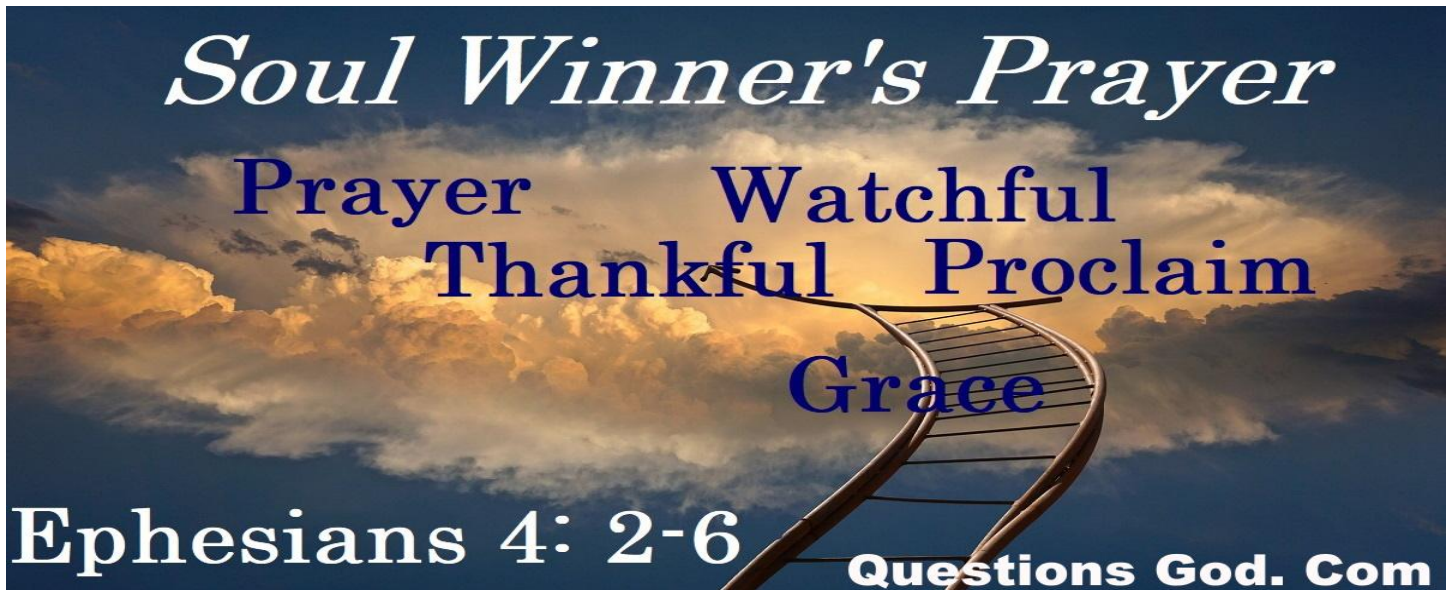


SHARING THE GOSPEL - "INTRODUCING OTHERS TO CHRIST"

PRAYER IS THE CATALYST IN SOUL-WINNING

Colossians 4:2-6

² "Devote yourselves to **PRAYER**, being **WATCHFUL**, and **THANKFUL**. ³ And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. ⁴ Pray that I may **PROCLAIM** it clearly, as I should. ⁵ Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. ⁶ Let your conversation be always **FULL OF GRACE**, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone."

PRAYER - WATCHFUL - THANKFUL - PROCLAIM - FULL OF GRACE

A SCRIPTURAL PRAYER PATTERN FOR SHARING THE GOSPEL:

Colossians 4:2-6 provides us an excellent scriptural prayer guideline to begin each day equipped to be a witness for Christ.

PRAYER

Whenever it comes to sharing the Gospel, we frequently pray for those individuals we want to share with. On the other hand, *prayer needs to also **prepare our hearts for witnessing, positioning us to be used by God.*** Pray for an abundance of **love and compassion** for the unbeliever. Pray for a deep **desire** to share the Gospel with others

and to recognize all opportunities to share the *Good News* with those God places before you. Pray for an **obedient** heart to act upon those opportunities.



BE WATCHFUL AND AWARE OF PEOPLE AROUND YOU: Allow the **Holy Spirit** to help you become more sensitive to His promptings on who to share the Gospel with throughout your day. This develops and cultivates with time and practical experience. You must be **prepared to respond** to opportunities; God probably will not bring people your way if you are not.

Opportunities will most likely present themselves in everyday conversations with people. **Ask questions** and engage them to tell you more. Be ready to **listen** carefully with grace and compassion. Share how God has helped and supported you or made an impact in your daily life that connects to what they are struggling with. It could be work-related, relationships, life goals, parenting, challenging decisions, etc. These stories of how God had a tremendous positive impact on your life will help open doors for you to share the Gospel with others.

BE THANKFUL AND APPRECIATIVE (Prepare Yourself)

The absolute best way to combat discouragement is by being grateful for everything the Lord has done. David says in Psalm 103:2, *"Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits."* Remembering what He has done for you motivates you to share the Gospel with others and helps **develop your faith** in what He can do in other people's lives. Take time to be **thankful** and appreciative of your **Salvation**. Also, be grateful that the Lord **guides**, protects, comforts, directs, and **provides** for you. Be very grateful for the opportunity to serve Jesus and that you can be His **witness** to point others to Him.

PROCLAIM THE MESSAGE CLEARLY AND EASILY

BE WELL PREPARED by taking time to discover the best way to share the Gospel precisely and effortlessly. Like in most things, practice will improve your delivery of the Gospel message. Do not be lazy and passive when explaining the Gospel. Explain it so that those individuals you share with will undoubtedly be able to make a decision. Every bit as vital is learning to rely **on the Holy Spirit** to soften the hearts of those people you share with so they will accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

We must depend on God to give us wisdom, understanding, and discernment. There is no such thing as sharing the Gospel flawlessly. So, do not let the adversary, the devil, beat you up and make you feel defeated by thinking you did it poorly. Depend upon the

Holy Spirit's power to help you make spiritual truths **easy to understand** for others. You'll be amazed at how the Holy Spirit will use what we share.



FULL OF GRACE

People can tell if you genuinely **care** about them. This is true of your next-door neighbors and acquaintances who know you. Your children know it. Even your *family dog* or cat can tell. The question is, do you care about those who don't know the Lord? Be gracious and thoughtful, and practice kindness and compassion when you share. Let the love and passion of Jesus flow through you to them.

Practice and preparation make a lot of difference in your presentation. (Much more on sharing your presentation in later study guides.) You are showing **respect** by being **gracious** and engaging in conversation with them.

Suggestion: Practice sharing the Gospel while looking in a mirror and question yourself if you would want to pay attention to "*the person in the mirror.*"

DEVELOP A HEART FOR SOUL-WINNING THROUGH PRAYER

PRAYER AFFECTS EVANGELISM

We are engaged in a battle. Paul, the apostle, uses wording throughout his letters that take hold of our hearts and helps advise us as Christians that a hidden war is raging in the heavens. Soul-winning, or evangelism, is a war statement on the principalities of darkness present in our world. The issues and problems at hand are life and death. We

cannot continue being indifferent in carrying out our responsibilities and duties as followers of Christ. Thus, prayer has to be permanently tied to soul-winning.

It's essential to be motivated by the mind and heart of Jesus. The best way to do that is to have God's Word at the heart of our lives. Also, sharing the Gospel is always more effective when **we talk to God before we talk to people**.

Simply put, prayer evangelism (prayer in sharing the Gospel) is talking to God about our next-door neighbors before we talk to our next-door neighbors about God. This definition has helped Christians who genuinely desire to share the Gospel with the lost but feel inadequate or scared to share.

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WHY IS PRAYER SO CRUCIAL IN SOUL WINNING?

1. PRAYER CONNECTS AND PLUGS US INTO THE HEART OF GOD.

This is the central and compelling reason to pray. John 15:5 says, *"I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."* This verse helps remind us that those who abide in God's presence will produce much fruit. Separated from God, we can do nothing.

Understanding God transforms us into having genuine compassion toward those hurting in this world. Additionally, it keeps us strong, healthy, balanced, and active in accomplishing the mission of *"introducing others to Christ."*

2. PRAYER KEEPS US ATTENTIVE TO THE HARVEST FIELD.

Jesus tells us in Matthew 9:37 that *"The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few."* He then commissions us to go in Matthew 9:38, *"Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."* This commission connects our prayers specifically to the release of workers to spread the *"Good News."*

Let us pray this way in our churches. Let's not get discouraged and disappointed that the laborers are few but be excited and fired up that the harvest is plentiful.

3. PRAYER FERVENTLY SEEKS GOD FOR MORE.

One night Jacob wrestled with God in Genesis 32:26. Jacob said, *"I will not let you go unless you bless me."* This type of passionate, fervent, desperate, determined prayer is undoubtedly out of fashion and not very popular today. Perhaps that is the main reason why we experience so little divine blessing on both individual members and the church as a whole. Because of this, we appear to have little effect and impact on the world around us. *(Pause, Think, Consider, and Reflect!)*

Stay connected to God by fervent prayer in seeking God for more. It does seem very clear that effective and fervent praying usually involves more than just saying the correct words. Seeking out God with your whole heart is the kind of Bible praying that secures not only answers but the true blessing of God that we all need. It's time to talk to God and start a direct conversation with Him today.

Lord, *"I will not let you go unless you bless Me."*

4. PRAYER ACTIVATES GOD'S POWER FOR US TO TELL OTHERS ABOUT CHRIST.

Prayer is one of the best tools that God has put in our toolboxes (resources), yet, it is often ignored. Prayer is our "**power cord**," which plugs us into the Holy Spirit to help us share the Gospel. If we overlook getting charged, we end up being ineffective as a force in expanding the kingdom of God.

Prayer destroys strongholds and opens doors for change resulting in transformed lives. Because of prayer, we are empowered to set out on our mission of spreading the "Good News," which gives us the courage to initiate conversations. Just think what could happen in your neighborhood if your church prayed together for people coming to Christ. I am sure many would come to know Christ.

5. PRAY TO BE BOLD.

Apostle Paul wrote about his fears and concerns about sharing the Gospel with others. But he firmly believed in the power of prayer and often asked for boldness. He requested the same prayer from others for him. Ephesians 6:19 says, *"Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the Gospel."*

When we engage in personal soul winning, we may lack courage. Let our preparation consist of persistently being in prayer and asking God for boldness, especially before you approach someone you plan to share the Gospel with, invite to a church service, or ask them to do a Bible study together. Say a brief and concise prayer asking God to give you the boldness required to say what you have planned to say.

PRAYER, HABIT, SEEKING, GIVING, INVITING, AND UNDERSTANDING



PRAYER:

- Prayer is an action and process that helps make us sensitive and receptive to God.
- Prayer is talking to God. (Listening carefully to God matters, too!)
- Reading the Bible daily.
- Hearing a sermon at church.
- The most effective soul-winning technique we have as Christians is prayer!
- By being men and women of prayer, we help remind ourselves why introducing others to Jesus matters!

HABIT:

How do you make one thing you do one or two times into a routine? Simply by doing it for 21 days in a row! What practices and patterns do we need to form?

SEEKING:

Seek God every day. Decide on a time that best works for you to spend time with God daily and stick to it. Be *Caring and compassionate*: ask someone, "*How is your relationship with God?*" Then ***listen*** carefully to the answer.

GIVING:

Provide for the needs of others before asking something of them. Show concern for others: provide a helping hand, be a friend, be a good listener, and if appropriate, give them a free Bible if needed.

INVITING:

Once you have displayed that you genuinely care for someone, invite:

- Invite them to study and learn the Bible with you.
- Invite them to church or a special event at your church.
- Invite the person to accept and receive Jesus as Lord.

UNDERSTANDING:

Understand your role. You matter in God's plan, which may be the only way someone can hear the Gospel message. You are God's instrument to reach others. Since you have an essential role to play, perform it well. Of course, it's not all regarding us, but we do make a difference.

IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND:

Jesus is the Way; He is our hope; without Jesus in our lives, there is no meaning, and we will not have an eternal future. We can't keep the joy and happiness of knowing the Lord to ourselves in a world filled with hurt and lost people. Can each of us seek to bring somebody to the Lord? God can use you to connect with others to spread His message and for others to know Him!

Apply "Who, What, When, Where, Why:"

- *Who* will you introduce to Jesus?
- *What* will you do to introduce them?
- *When* will you introduce them?
- *Where* will you introduce them?
- *Why* will you introduce them?



A HEART-TO-HEART TALK

"JUST DO IT!" "JUST DO IT!"

This statement above has good and bad meanings depending on what generation you are born in. Today, let's look at "*Just Do It!*" from a Christian perspective for anyone sharing the Gospel.

I sometimes have this mental picture of someone on the 99th floor of a company making decisions for the guy on the first

floor living with many hurts. When we meet someone hurting, it is easy not to do something. It is easy for us to "*pass the buck,*" so to speak.

Within my spirit, many times in these situations, I scream, "*Just Do It!*" Why are we passing the problem to someone else multiple times? Is it also our responsibility as Christians to help those seeking answers? Why does it sometimes get redirected to others to help that person? We only want to get involved if it is convenient for us. Inside I am feeling "*Just Do It!*" This lost soul matters to God, which is what Jesus wants you to care for and build a relationship with. Who cares if you do not do it perfectly. Guess what? All of us will make mistakes in sharing.

Moral of the story: Do not "*pass it on*" to someone else when you are fully capable of introducing someone to the Lord and the "*Good News*" of the Gospel. Don't let your first reaction or desire be to let someone else help, like a pastor, local church, or other congregation members. You are just as qualified to help someone as anyone else in your Christian community. Our spiritual mindset has to be: "*Just do it!*"

Please commit to daily prayer and read God's Word even if you do not feel like it. God has chosen you, His people, to be His testimony in the world. He is calling us to commit to Him and carry out His commands. **Prayer** represents a commitment to walk with our Lord, reading God's Word (the Bible), introducing others to Christ (witnessing), growing in Christ, and receiving the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

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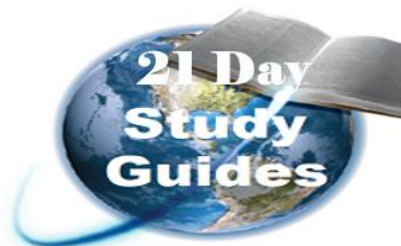
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
